RESEARCH QUESTIONS:

DO HEADS OF STATE WHO ENGAGE IN EXTREME FORMS OF VIOLENCE AGAINST THEIR OWN POPULATIONS OR FOREIGN POPULATIONS INADVERTENTLY GIVE AWAY THEIR INTENTIONS IN WHAT THEY SAY?

COULD THE RISK OF WARS AND SEEMINGLY IRRATIONAL (E.G. HIGH RISK OR COSTLY) ACTS OF AGGRESSION, RESULTING IN GENOCIDES AND OTHER ATROCITIES, BE PREDICTED BASED ON THE SOCIO-PSYCHOLOGICAL DRIVERS THAT LEADERS UNINTENTIONALLY REVEAL VIA THEIR SPEECHES?

The aim of our Calleva project is to establish an evidence-based psycholinguistic framework that can assess the risk that despotic leaders of autocratic states will resort to violent forms of repression domestically or hawkish foreign policies when the use of violence in these contexts carries high risk to self and group.

The project will use a mixed methods approach, coupling qualitative text analysis with quantitative natural language processing (NLP) analysis.
